

What is FLYING HIGHER?

FLYING HIGHER is a nature-based ecology camp that gets children out in nature -- and in the water -- to discover the great diversity of life. Participants will learn scientific field biology skills all while having fun and exploring nature. Be prepared to get dirty!

Who can come to Flying Higher?

FLYING HIGHER is for students currently in 6th through 8th grades.

When and Where is Flying Higher?

FLYING HIGHER will run Tuesday and Wednesday, June 13-14 from 9 am Tuesday through 2 pm Wednesday at Audubon's Rowe Sanctuary near Gibbon, Nebraska. This includes an overnight stay at Rowe Sanctuary.

How much does FLYING HIGHER cost?

Registration is \$125 and includes three meals.

Scholarships are available based on financial need, foster care or multiple siblings attending Flying Higher and Platte River Safari (formerly SOAR) camps. Please call 308-468-5282 and ask for Beka for more information.

Refunds are as follows: \$80 at 3 weeks or more before camp, \$50 at 1-3 weeks before camp, and \$0 at 1 week before camp.
