# Audubon | NEBRASKA code of Conduct and Volunteer Agreement

As a volunteer at Iain Nicolson Audubon Center at Rowe Sanctuary your personal conduct is vital to creating a fun, friendly, equitable, and educational experience for all who visit and work here. To facilitate this atmosphere, this code of conduct and volunteer agreement has been established. The code is a set of policies that allow for diversity while establishing clear, acceptable guidelines for conducting yourself while on duty and participating in activities.

Also, as part of the National Audubon Society, our volunteers as well as are staff, are expected to understand, agree to, and follow our Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion mission. Please read the following and initial your agreement at the end of the statement.

"Just as biodiversity strengthens natural systems, the diversity of human experience strengthens our conservation efforts for the benefit of nature and all human beings. Audubon staff and volunteers must represent and reflect that human diversity, embracing it in all the communities where we work, in order to achieve our conservation goals. As an Audubon volunteer, you are dedicated to fostering an inclusive, communal environment that prioritizes fairness and respect and brings us together as a caring community of people who are inspired by birds and want to protect them. We respect the individuality of each member of our community, and are committed to an environment free of any kind of discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex, age, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, disability, national or ethnic origin, politics, or veteran status." \_\_\_\_\_ (initials)

### Volunteers agree to:

- Authorize an independent, confidential criminal background check (if over 18)
- Follow all guidelines, policies and procedures
- · Appear clean, neat and appropriately attired
- Treat others with respect, patience, courtesy and tact
- Be professional, positive, approachable, helpful and courteous
- Be flexible, cooperative and supportive of all volunteers and staff members
- Be well informed and knowledgeable when presenting information to visitors
- Be prompt and reliable in reporting for scheduled volunteer shifts
- Call the Volunteer Coordinator if not able to report for duty as scheduled as early as possible
- Respect the principle of confidentiality
- Record hours volunteered in the designated manner
- Comply with all policies outlined in "General Conduct for the Protection of Young People" and the "Guidelines for Appropriate Affection and Interactions with Young People."
- Immediately report any observations of inappropriate behaviors or possible policy violations to Volunteer Coordinator
- Understand that irregular attendance, poor performance, or failure to cooperate with staff and policies may be interpreted as a desire to resign
- Accept that Rowe Sanctuary has the right to revoke volunteer privileges

#### Volunteers shall not:

- Deliberately or neglectfully waste, damage or steal personal, guest, or Rowe Sanctuary property
- Use profanity, inappropriate jokes, nor any kind of harassment

I understand that my participation in the Program may involve sustained strenuous physical activity. I am in good health and am aware of no physical problem or condition that will limit or interfere with my ability to participate in the Program.

I agree that I am participating in the Program at my own risk, and acknowledge that Audubon has made no warranty or representation, expressed or implied, regarding the safety of conducting the Program.

I expressly release and hold harmless Audubon and its officers, directors, employees, agents, licensees, successors and assigns from and for any and all claims, demands, actions and causes of action whatsoever for (i) libel, defamation, invasion of privacy or right of publicity arising from Audubon's use or alteration of My Likeness (or any part thereof); or (ii) any loss, damage or injury to person or to property suffered or incurred by me in connection with the Program or any aspect of it, including, but not limited to, any transportation arranged by, paid for or provided by Audubon.
